SCHOOL COUNSELOR

HELPING YOUR CHILD STAY ORGANIZED

Homework Area: Take a look at your child's homework space. If cluttered, help your child make decisions on what to keep, recycle, or file. **Agenda Book:** Inspect your child's agenda book. **Backpacks:** Encouraging your child to regularly clean out his/her book bag. Loose papers should be filed immediately. **Binders:** Verify that your child has an effective way to store and access important papers. Labeling binders/folders and keeping them easily accessible is key. **Family Calendars:** Having a family calendar filled with dates (such as doctor appointments, practices, events, even chores) can be very useful as well as a good way to model for your children the importance of remaining organized.

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
