

Dear Parents,

My name is Ms. Terez Woodward. I am your students school Nurse. I would like to remind you that fall is the start of **FLU SEASON**. Below are some of the important things you can do to help keep your children healthy and well.

- Get a flu shot!!!
- Wash your hands
- Stay home when you are sick
- Say no to sugar (sugar lowers your immune response)
- Meditate, (this can activate your immune system and decreases stress)

Guidelines for Keeping Students Home from School

Keeping your children home when they are sick will help us prevent the spread of that illness to other students since children are in close contact with one another at school. The following are some guidelines to help you decide when to keep your child home from school:

- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Ear drainage
- Sore throat
- Persistent cough
- · Runny nose if the discharge is yellow
- Oral temperature over 100 degrees.
- Headache or stomach ache in combination with other symptoms (i.e., cough or sore throat)
