COVID-19 Vaccine Information for DPS Students - 16 and Older!

Vaccines are another tool in our toolbox in ensuring that our schools are healthy and safe for students and staff, and we are excited to partner with Denver Health and Children's Hospital Colorado to offer vaccinations to our eligible students. Currently, vaccines are available in Colorado for those 16 years old and older. <u>Find out when you're eligible</u>.

DPS' healthcare partners would like to support our students in accessing the COVID-19 vaccines as soon as possible, for those who would like to get one:

- Denver Health: Eligible students ages 16 and older may contact our School-Based Health Centers at 303-602-8958 to get connected to a vaccine appointment. In addition to providing vaccines to students at their existing clinic sites, Denver Health will be operating <u>6 drive-up</u> <u>clinics at DPS school sites</u> in late April and early May; appointments are required. Parental consent either in person or with a current signed <u>consent to treat form</u> on file in the Denver Health system is required for students ages 16 and 17.
- Children's Hospital Colorado: Eligible students ages 16 and older and their families may
 register for vaccine appointments using their <u>web portal</u>. Children's Colorado will then contact
 you directly to schedule your appointment. Appointment invitations expire after 72 hours. All
 individuals under the age of 18 must have exactly one parent or legally authorized guardian
 present with them to sign a physical consent form at both the first and second dose appointments.
 Full instructions for navigating the Children's Colorado process can be found <u>here</u>. Patients and
 families with questions about receiving the vaccine at Children's Colorado can review these <u>FAQs</u>

Did you know that in December, 2020, the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) updated the US Citizenship test. <u>The test now has 128 questions and applicants will need to answer more questions correctly. The geography section was removed and the history and civics test expanded, resulting in a longer test requiring more complete answers. FREE COVID TESTING!

DPS is pleased to announce we are expanding our partnership with COVIDCheck Colorado to offer our <u>free COVID-19 testing for students</u> to support a safe return to school. Our full community of students and staff will now have the opportunity to take an initial COVID-19 test before coming back to school as well as ongoing screening tests every other week... The test will be completed via nasal PCR test or SalivaDirect[™], and results will be returned within 36-72 hours.
