Dear Parents,

I hope this message finds you well. As we reach the end of this school year, I want to thank you again for all you have done to support PBA. This year has been like no other, and I cannot express enough gratitude for how students, educators and families at home have responded and helped us overcome the many challenges we faced. In spite of all that has happened, we have still made progress towards our goals of improving the school and are in a position to have a strong year in 2021-2022. Again, thank you for all you have done to support your children at home this year. We are extremely hopeful to mostly return to a normal school experience in August (including seeing our parents and families in the building).

As we transition to next year, I want to share some high level information with you.

Our school bell times will be 9:10 to 4:10. This is not a huge shift from what we have had in the past, but is slightly later than it has been.

Also, we will be having a periodic early release days, so that we can allow for teacher professional development and planning time. Our bus arrival and dismissal times make it difficult to have sufficient time before or after school to plan for instruction or engage in professional learning. Because if that, we have decided to have an early release on every other Wednesday next year. I recognize that this may cause some inconveniences for some families. I am sorry to ask this of our community, but feel it is important that we support our teachers in being well planned and prepared to deliver high quality instruction every day. We also want to to develop them as professionals via various learning opportunities, and ensure they have adequate time to analyze their student data and inform their teaching. We feel confident that this time spent will have a beneficial impact on the teaching and learning at PBA in general. Did you know that in December, 2020, the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) updated the US Citizenship test. The test now has 128 questions and applicants will need to answer more questions correctly. The geography section was removed and the history and civics test expanded, resulting in a longer test requiring more complete answers. FREE COVID TESTING!

DPS is pleased to announce we are expanding our partnership with COVIDCheck Colorado to offer our <u>free COVID-19 testing for students</u> to support a safe return to school. Our full community of students and staff will now have the opportunity to take an initial COVID-19 test before coming back to school as well as ongoing screening tests every other week... The test will be completed via nasal PCR test or SalivaDirect™, and results will be returned within 36-72 hours.
