In-Person Safety Orientation - Dates and Times for All 2nd - 8th Grade Students Who Chose In-Person Learning!

Dear Families,

We were excited to welcome our 1st graders back into the building this week. It is nice to now have three grade levels at the school as we continue with our gradual switch to in-person learning for the students who have opted to do so.

Safety Orientations:

For the students who have chosen in-person learning, we will be providing opportunities for the remaining grade levels to come to the school the week of October 12th. During this time, they will go through a short orientation and practice our safety protocols before they return to school on the 21st. Students in 2nd through 8th grade are invited to come during the following times that week:

- Monday 10/12 2nd grade 9:00 to 11:00
- Tuesday 10/13 3rd grade 9:00 to 11:00 and 6th grade 1:00 to 3:00
- Wednesday 10/14 -4th grade 9:00 to 11:00 and 7th grade 1:00 to 3:00
- Thursday 10/15 5th grade 9:00 to 11:00 and 8th grade 1:00 to 3:00

Unfortunately, we are unable to provide transportation for these times and understand that it will be difficult for many of our student to get here. Because of that, these sessions are not mandatory. We

encourage students to attend, but will rely on virtual training opportunities if they are unable to do so. If you have chosen virtual learning for your child, they do not need to attend.

In order to conduct these orientation sessions, teachers will be providing asynchronous content during these times and will not be conducting their normal live instruction. Please be on the lookout for communication from your child's teacher with specific details on the orientation.

Fall Conferences:

I also want to share information on Fall Conferences this year.

- All conferences will be virtual this year.
- We will be identifying a window of time for conferences to take place, in order to give teachers the flexibility to have meetings with families either before or after in-person return.
- The window for conferences will be from 10/12 to 10/30.
- Please look out for information from your child's teacher on when they plan to schedule their conferences.
- October 16th is the DPS conference day, and is a non-student contact day. We will be conducting our conferences in the afternoons and evenings throughout the window described above.
