# PANDEMIC-EBT APPLICATION PROCESS IS STILL OPEN TILL SEPTEMBER ENDING - APPLY NOW IF YOU HAVE NOT DONE SO!

P-EBT provides families with children eligible for free or reduced-price school meals with funds to help buy food since schools were closed this Spring due to the pandemic. You can receive up to \$279 per eligible child to stretch your food budget. Click **HERE** to start your application.

### **Common P-EBT Question and Answer:**

What if a family does not have a SS number? While providing a Social Security Number for the head of household helps with EBT card issuance, families will still be able to apply for P-EBT without a Social Security Number.

Can a family receive a check? No, If the household does not have an EBT card in their possession,a P-EBT card will be issued by mail.

A Parent-to-Para class is being offered virtually by the Family and Community Engagement (FACE) Centers this fall. After successful completion of this program offers participants a pipeline to employment to Denver Public Schools. The class is taught in English only using the Google Classroom platform.
