Dear Families,

Please be informed that we will begin the Colorado Measures of Academic Success (CMAS) assessments on March 22, 2021- April 30, 2021. These Assessments are aligned to the Colorado Academic Standards, which are statewide expectations of what students should know and be able to do at the end of each grade. CMAS testing is for grades 3-8. All students will test for three days in math and literacy. 5th and 8th grade will test a fourth day in science.

#### **OPTING OUT:**

While we believe that these tests are important, we understand that some families may decide they do not want to come in-person to participate in testing this year due to COVID-19. All testing must be done in person as there is no remote testing option. If you choose to opt out, you must fill out the opt out form located in the Parent Portal under the "See All Apps" tab by clicking on the link for Complete Assessment Opt-Out Form. This form is available for both students learning in-person and those learning in the virtual program. Please complete this form no later than February 26 as this information is vital to our planning process. We need to have an exact count of students who will and will not be participating so that we can adjust staffing, testing schedules and adhere to all health and safety

guidelines. After February 26th, you will then be required to complete the Opt-Out form through Infinite Campus for each student.



The test now has 128 questions and applicants will need to answer more questions correctly. The geography section was removed and the history and civics test expanded, resulting in a longer test requiring more complete answers. DPS is pleased to announce we are expanding our partnership with COVIDCheck Colorado to offer our <u>free COVID-19 testing for students</u> to support a safe return to school. Our full community of students and staff will now have the opportunity to take an initial COVID-19 test before coming back to school as well as ongoing screening tests every other week... The test will be completed via nasal PCR test or SalivaDirect™, and results will be returned within 36-72 hours.
